The Tracklements Company are a food manufacturer based in the heart of Wiltshire. The company makes an award-winning range of over 60 artisan condiments, from the UK's first Wholegrain Mustard to the Original Onion Marmalade.

The company is dedicated to sustainable food manufacturing and only use 100% environmentally friendly electricity.

In the height of summer the company can operate on 100% 'home-grown' electricity generated on-site from their solar PV system. For the winter months, the organisation has partnered with Good Energy to ensure that 100% of the electricity they import and use is both renewable and sustainable.

Following the success of their first installation, The Tracklements Company returned to install another 269 modules to form another 67.25kWp solar PV system as part of phase two. The company is now exploring further options to form phase three due for completion in 2021.

To date the combined clean energy systems are capable of generating more than 64MWh of clean electricity per year - which is enough energy to boil 640,000 kettles or to keep your Tracklements ketchup cool in a fridge for more than 129-years.
